



Code of Conduct for Parents / Carers

- ✓ Remember that children play for their fun, not yours.
- ✓ Encourage your child always to play by the rules and to respect the instructors, officials, and volunteers.
- ✓ Encourage children to play, do not force them.
- ✓ Praise your child's good efforts whether they win or lose.
- ✓ Applaud all good play.
- ✓ Never ridicule a child for losing or making a mistake.
- ✓ Children learn best by following a good example.
- ✓ Learn the rules to better understand what you are looking for / commenting on.
- ✓ Instructor's decision should never be questioned.
- ✓ If any problems / questions / concerns discuss it with the instructor – not other parents.
- ✓ Do not question the judgement of and show your appreciation to all officials, instructors and helpers.
- ✓ Condemn the use of violence, profane language, and any form of abuse.
- ✓ Think of how you can best help the instructors and / or the club.
- ✓ As a spectator you must never enter the field of play / activity.
